Star Wars Day Welcomes Special Guests Lee Kohse and **Stephen Castantino To Tatooine**

Star Wars fans love diving into the history and nuances of their favorite fandom. On Saturday, February 4, 2023, the Star Wars Day event will let them do just that. LANDS welcomes two special guests: Star Wars artist Lee Kohse, and Stephen Castantino, who played a Gamorrean Guard in the film. Each guest will take to the main stage for a Q & A session. The first, with Lee Kohse, is designed to give in-depth insight into the visuals of the Star Wars universe. The second, with Stephen Castantino, will discuss what it was like on the Imperial Valley set of "Return of the Jedi" in 1982.

Artist Lee Kohse is a California-born artist who provides illustrations for many projects – Star Wars, Lord of the Rings, Aliens, The Karate Kid, Transformers, and more. He has provided images for Lucasfilm since 2006 and continues to contribute to the worlds of Star Wars and Indiana Jones. In addition to the Q&A, Mr. Kohse has graciously agreed to judge this year's art show, comprised of Star Wars fan and desert art in a wide variety of mixed mediums. Art show awards and the Q&A session with Mr. Kohse begins at 4:00pm at the main stage.

Stephen Castantino was on set for the filming of the Sarlacc Pit Monster scene as a Gamorrean Guard on Jabba's barge. A native of Hoboken, New Jersey, Stephen developed a passion for music at a young age. He moved to California in 1978, and met Corey Dee Williams (son of actor Billy Dee Williams) in a martial arts class in Los Angeles. The two became friends, starting a band together. The Q&A sessions with our special guests will begin at 4:00 (Mr. Kohse) and 4:30 (Mr. Castentino) on the main stage.
