About the Project

The Sports Field Restroom and Concession, Sport Field Westside Lighting, and Border Link Antenna Project is a collaborative effort project, which brings together IVC Athletics, POST (The Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training), and Information Technology.

In August 2018, the President's Cabinet prioritized the need to provide lighting for the track & field, and the POST academy's obstacle course, along with providing a restroom facility for the athletic fields.

In 2019, the President's Cabinet prioritized looking into providing street lighting along the westside perimeter road between the POST academy's obstacle course to the track & field. This improvement was spearheaded by the Public Safety Department to provide a safe luminated pathway for their outdoor training exercise routines.

The Imperial Valley Telecommunications Authority (IVTA) is a collaborative of all Imperial County school districts, city agencies, county agencies, Imperial Community College and San Diego State University-IVC. IVTA is dedicated to provide new technology and a community-wide system access to the Imperial Valley Public agencies, and contribute to the growth and development of the community. In 2021, with the support of the IVC Board of Trustees, approved Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds (HEERF) to install a borderlink antenna on campus that will help increase capacity to the entire wireless network. This new borderlink antenna will add to the current goal to 30 antennas throughout the County.

This Project is being funded by the Building Fund, Categorical Funding, and HEERF.

Total funding for this Project is approximately \$6.9 Million Dollars. The contractor is Erickson-Hall Construction. The Architect of Record is Sanders Architecture. The Inspector of Record is Precision Inspections.

This Project was brought forth by the advocacy of IVC Athletics, the Health and Public Safety Department, IVTA, the Academic Services Department, the Administrative Services Department, all under the leadership of the Imperial Community College District Board of Trustees.
