Selected speakers will have the opportunity to rehearse with a speech coach to develop their presentations.

"We are thrilled to be expanding our second TEDxAWC and welcoming even more members of our community to participate," Dr. Amani shared. "I can't wait to see how our speakers inspire us with their ideas for transformation."

Interested applicants are invited to share stories of transformation—whether personal, professional, or societal—that have led to growth and thriving in the face of challenges. Submissions will be evaluated based on the strength of the idea and its alignment with the "Transform & Thrive" theme.

The deadline for submitting the 250-word proposal is **December 8**. Applicants that make it through the first round will be asked to submit an audition video. Please review <u>TEDx Content Guidelines</u> and <u>TEDx Speaker Guidelines</u> prior to applying.
