Plays mood music between games & innings to create a lively, fun atmosphere. Equipment provided.

Interested parties are encouraged to share their availability and a contact will be in touch. Games may start as early as 9 a.m. or run as last as 11 p.m. Even a single volunteer shift would make a world of difference.
