Winterhaven, Ca. School Shooting Threats

On Tuesday, May 06, 2025, at approximately 9:00 p.m., the Imperial County Sheriff's Office was contacted by the Quechan Police Department in reference to an unidentified subject posting a potential threat of a shooting at a San Pasqual School.

The Imperial County Sheriff's Office and the Quechan Police Department worked together to locate the individual who posted a screenshot of this threat on social media. Once that individual was located, statements were provided and Imperial County Sheriff's Office Investigators worked with the social media platform to identify the account holder who created and posted the initial threat.

Investigators immediately conducted a follow-up with the account holder in Winterhaven, California. A subsequent search of the residence was conducted, and no weapons were located. A juvenile suspect was identified at the residence. That juvenile was placed under arrest for Criminal Threats and booked into the Imperial County Juvenile Hall.

The Imperial County Sheriff's Office will fully investigate any type of threat and will continue to work with allied agencies to ensure the continued safety and security of our community and schools.

The San Pasqual School District has been made aware of this incident and worked diligently with the Sheriff's Office to ensure the successful outcome in this case.

At this time there are no additional threats or known suspects in this case and the juvenile arrested was the sole suspect in this matter. Parents and students are encouraged to continue working with law enforcement to report all concerns regarding community and school safety.
