City of El Centro Announces ARAM Street Work Scheduled Aug. 25-27

EL CENTRO, Calif. — Tuesday, Aug. 25, 2026 — The City of El Centro is continuing work on its 2026 Street Overlay Project, with asphalt rubber aggregate membrane, or ARAM, chip-seal activities scheduled on several city streets from today through Aug. 27.

ARAM is a pavement preservation treatment that uses asphalt rubber and aggregate to seal and protect the roadway surface and help extend the life of the pavement.

Work is scheduled in the following areas:

Tuesday, Aug. 25

- Fairfield Drive, from Ross Avenue to Mineo Avenue
- Aurora Drive, from Fairfield Avenue to Dogwood Avenue
- West Ross Avenue, from Fourth Street to Third Street
- Third Street, from Ross Avenue to Orange Avenue

Wednesday, Aug. 26

- Manzanita Drive, from the alley to Eighth Street
- Jacaranda Drive, from the alley to Eighth Street
- Danenberg Drive, from the alley to Eighth Street
- Cypress Drive, from Manzanita Drive to Danenberg Drive
- Lenrey Avenue, from Court to Lotus Avenue

Thursday, Aug. 27

- Lotus Avenue, from Court to Ross Avenue
- 23rd Avenue, from Desert Gardens Drive to Ross Avenue
- Desert Gardens Drive, from 24th Street to 22nd Street
- 23rd Avenue, from Pepper Drive to Ocotillo Drive
- Pepper Drive, from 23rd Street to Pepper Court
- Pepper Court, from Pepper Drive to 22nd Street
- State Street, from Lotus Avenue to 23rd Street

Motorists traveling through the affected areas should use caution, follow posted traffic-control signs and directions from construction crews, and allow additional time for possible delays. Residents are also asked to avoid parking vehicles within active construction areas to allow crews to complete the work safely and efficiently.

The construction schedule is subject to change due to weather, field conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.

The City of El Centro appreciates the public's patience and cooperation as work continues to improve and preserve local streets.
